DENTAL CARE REQUIREMENTS •

Below are requirements that apply to the attending/consultant Dentist providing dental services for a resident of this facility. These requirements are based upon the <u>State Health Code</u>, <u>Rules and Regulations and federal Medicaid and Medicare guidelines</u> for residential health care facilities, and policies established by the facility Quality Assessment and Review Committee.

- THE DENTIST (OR DESIGNEE) MUST COMPLETE AN ORAL EXAM WITHIN FOURTEEN (14) DAYS OF ADMISSION AND DOCUMENT DENTAL STATUS IN THE MEDICAL RECORD.
- WHENEVER A RESIDENT REQUIRES ASSESSMENT/TREATMENT RELATED TO ROUTINE CARE OR PROVISON OF COMPLETE AND PARTIAL DENTURES; THE CLEANING, REPAIR AND RESTORATION OF DENTURES/TEETH; SURGERY AND PERIODONTAL THERAPY...the dentist (or designee) must visit the resident and document the care and treatment rendered in the medical record.
- <u>TWELVE (12) MONTHS AFTER THE LAST FULL DENTAL ASSESSMENT</u>... the dentist (or designee) must complete a dental examination and update the medical record.
- PROVIDE BASIC SUPPLIES FOR DENTAL CARE OF RESIDENTS ... as established by the contract..
- <u>IF A DENTIST FAILS TO PERFORM REQUIRED SERVICES OR VISITS</u>... the Administrator must assign a dentist to provide the necessary care requirements for a resident.
- WHEN RECEIVING STAFF TELEPHONE CALLS BETWEEN VISITS... the dentist (or designee) is expected to return the call as appropriate.
- WHEN THE ATTENDING/CONSULTANT DENTIST IS NOT AVAILABLE TO PROVIDE CARE... the facility will arrange timely dental as appropriate.
