

Visitor Fact Sheet

Welcome to Elderwood!

We are excited to be able to welcome you. As we continue to deal with the COVID-19 Pandemic, additional precautions are required to keep our residents and their guests safe from possible infection.

As you visit today, please keep the following in mind:

- Appointments may be required to ensure we can maintain social distance recommendations and ensure all residents have the opportunity to welcome visitors.
- Testing 72 hours prior to your visit is strongly recommended, but not mandatory. Testing may also be available on site.
- Residents currently in quarantine, residents who have an active COVID-19 infection, and residents who live in close proximity to a resident with COVID-19 are not able to welcome visitors.
- Do not enter for visitation without completing a health screening.
- Please remain in the area designated for your visit.
- All visitors younger than 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Please sanitize your hands before and after your visit.
- If the resident is fully vaccinated, they can choose to have close contact (including touch) with visitors.
- Please wear a mask at all times while on the grounds of our facility.
- Please maintain social distance from other residents and staff in the facility.
- Please adhere to all instructions provided by Elderwood staff.
- Please be respectful of, and avoid contact with other visitors.
- There is no smoking anywhere on the grounds of Elderwood.
- Staff will be happy to answer questions.

Visitors may be required to leave at any time if they are unwilling or unable to comply with visitation guidelines or direction from staff.
